IT'S WONDERFUL TO BE TOGETHER! Here are some guidelines:

- **Seating:** Every other pew will be blocked off and only half of the pew will be open for seating. The side of the pew closest to the wall will be available for sitting and there will be tape marking the available seating areas.
- **Bulletin Distribution:** Bulletins will be passed out at the door, along with communion kits, by a gloved Elder.
- **Face-coverings:** Masks will be required and should be on prior to entering the sanctuary. There will be an usher outside to provide masks and hand sanitizer before entering the building.
- **Offerings:** While online and mailed-in offerings are still encouraged, there will be an offering plate on the table at the entrance of the sanctuary. There will not be an offering taken during the liturgy.

- **Children's Ministry:** There will not be kids Sunday School or activity kits available for children.
- **Bible Classes:** classes will continue on Zoom.
- **Space Usage:** Room 6 and the courtyard will be closed and there will not be coffee or social time.
- **Sanitizing:** Seats, doors, and common areas will be cleaned and sanitized in between services.
- **Communion:** The Lord's Supper will be administered using hermetically sealed cups and wafers (www.wccups.com). The common cup/chalice will not be available.
- **Dismissal:** Each row/pew will be released one by one at the end of the service.
